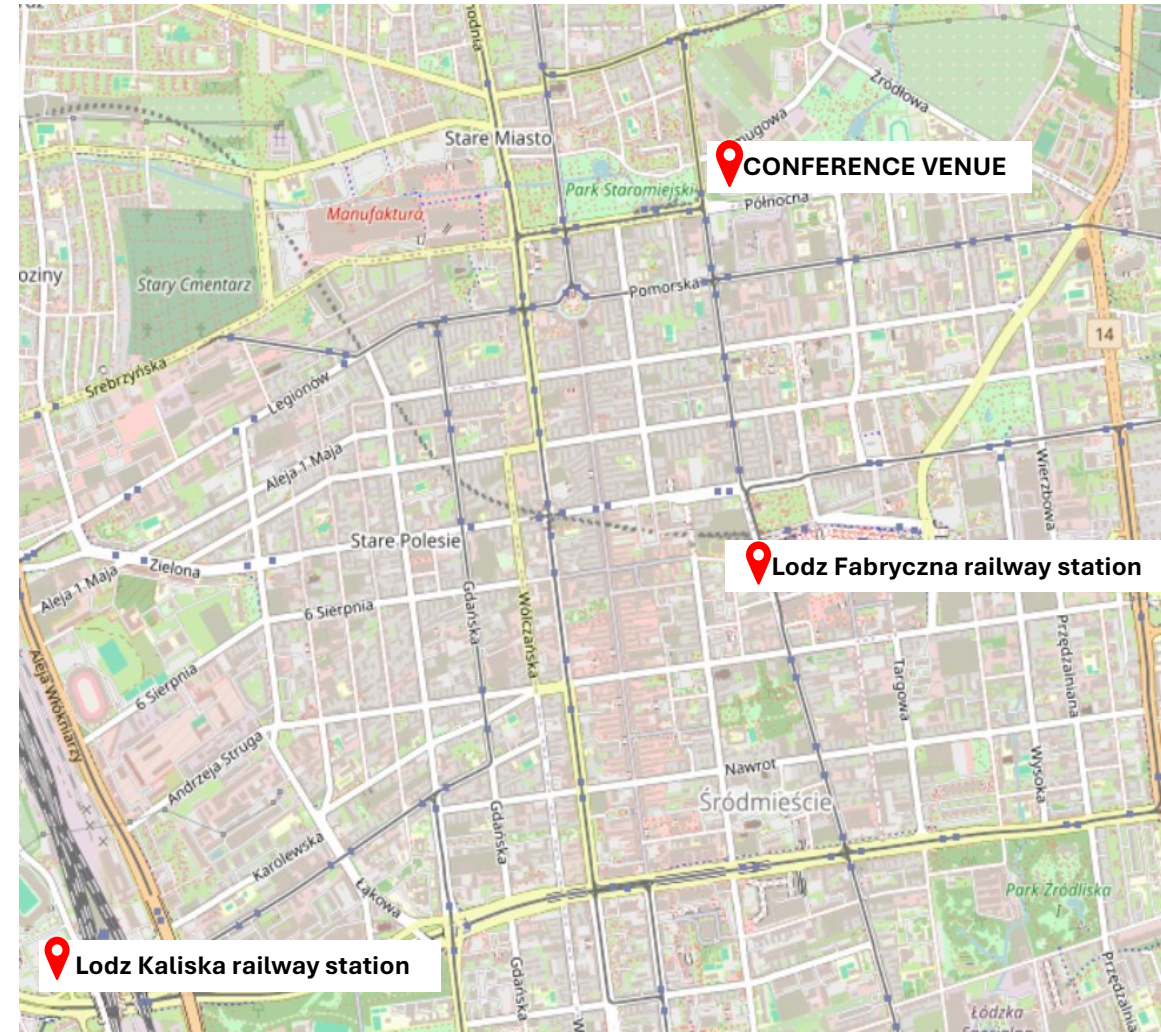

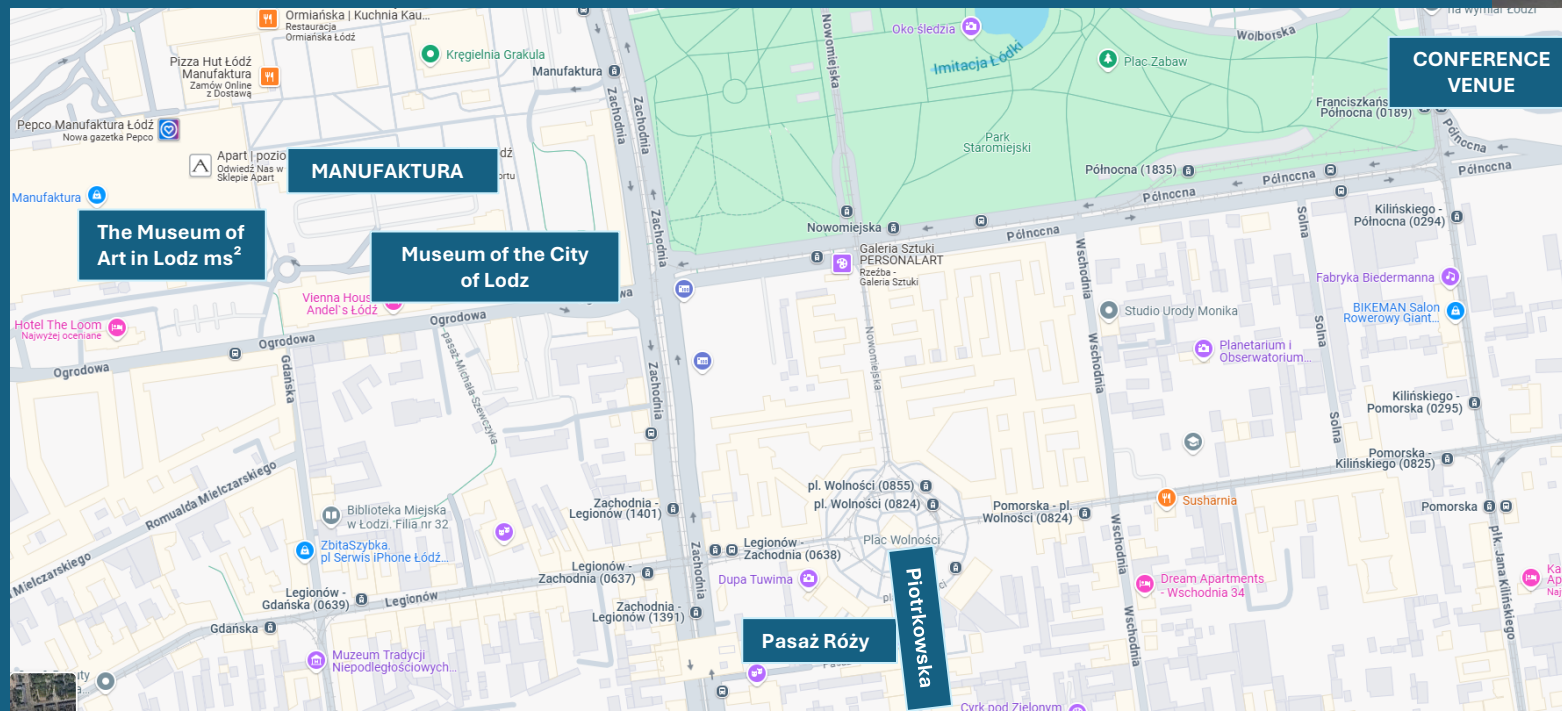
TOURIST ATTRACTIONS NEARBY

Manufaktura – a shopping, service and entertainment centre. Situated in the restored buildings of the former Izrael Poznański factory.



Piotrkowska Street – the symbol of Łódź. The longest promenade in Poland. It runs for over 4 km, from north to south, from Wolności Square to Independence Square. It is a unique complex of 19th-century metropolitan buildings in the country. One of its attractions is the Łódź Alley of Stars, which has been around for over 25 years. The avenue features over 100 stars: actors, directors, cameramen, set designers and composers.

Museum of the City of Lodz. Izrael Poznański Palace - a neo-Baroque factory palace from the 19th century, due to its size and decorations, it is called the "Lodz Louvre".



The Museum of Art in Łódź – the first institution of its kind in Europe and the second in the world (after the Museum of Modern Art in New York). The Museum of Art in Łódź is currently the only museum in Poland with such a rich collection of world art of the 20th and 21st centuries.



Pasaż Róży – an artistic project covering the courtyard of the tenement house at 3 Piotrkowska Street.
