TOURIST ATTRACTIONS NEARBY



The Museum of Art in Lodz
19 Ogrodowa Street
The first institution of its kind in Europe and the second in the world (after the Museum of Modern Art in New York). The Museum of Art in Lodz is currently the only museum in Poland with such a rich collection of world art of the 20th and 21st centuries.



Museum of the City of Lodz
15 Ogrodowa Street
Israel Poznański Palace – a neo-Baroque factory palace from the 19th century, due to its size and decorations, it is called the "Lodz Louvre"



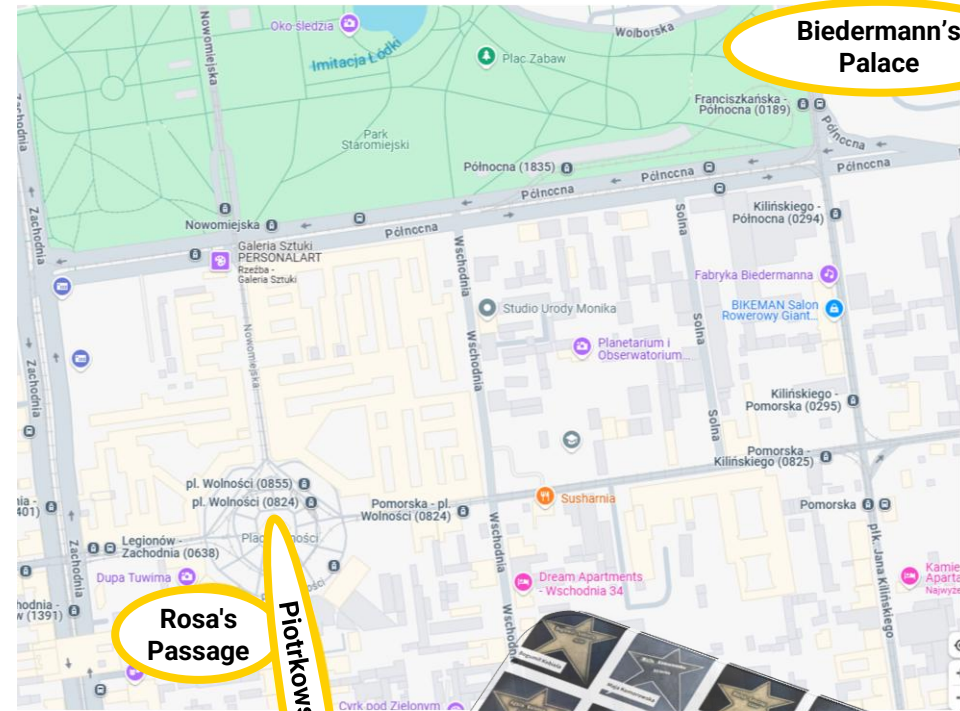
Manufaktura
– a shopping, service and entertainment centre. Situated in the restored buildings of the former Izrael Poznański factory.



Rosa's Passage (Pasaż Róży)

3 Piotrkowska Street

An artistic project covering the courtyard of the tenement house. The installation by Joanna Rajkowska, creator of the famous Warsaw palm tree, is one of the most spectacular projects in Lodz's urban space. The mirrored mosaic, which covers the walls of buildings, creates an incredible visual effect, completely transforming the space.

Piotrkowska Street

– the symbol of Łódź. The longest promenade in Poland. It runs for over 4 km, from north to south, from Wolności Square to Independence Square. It is a unique complex of 19th-century metropolitan buildings in the country. One of its attractions is the Lodz Alley of Stars, which has been around for over 25 years. The Alley of Stars stretches between 6 Sierpnia and Traugutta Streets, the Artur Rubinstein Passage, and Moniuszki Street. Jan Machulski came up with the idea of creating the Alley, modeled after Hollywood's Walk of Fame, in 1996. The first brass star – for actor Andrzej Seweryn – was installed on May 28, 1998. The avenue features over 100 stars: actors, directors, cameramen, set designers and composers. On the even (east) side there are stars of directors and cinematographers, while on the odd (west) side there are stars of actors.
